Cleaning Your Work Station

Although we may have left flu season in our rear view mirror, keeping a tidy work station is still an important habit to form. The following cleaning suggestions are simple ways to help you keep your desk feeling fresh and clean, which can lead to a more refreshed YOU!

Once a month, you may want to clean your computer screen to give you the best clarity possible.
